Directions: From the N1 take the R513 Sefako Makgatho Drive off-ramp (old Zambezi) to Cullinan. After 1km turn left on the R573 to KwaMhlanya (Moloto Rd). After approx. 7km turn left to Buffelsdrif (just after passing the Spar on your right). After 6km of dirt road (going through the main gate on your way) turn right at Bosbok Street. At the T-junction, ±500m further on turn left, then look for the sign "Shongololo" and turn right. Meet at Rob's house.

According to *Birding in Gauteng* this scenic drive traverses some of the most diverse birding habitats in the region, including prime Highveld grassland, only a stone's throw away from an impressive gorge cloaked with moist woodland.

This area is one of the lesser known birding spots in the region and has been quite literally 'put on the map' by Birding Big Day teams taking advantage of the variety of habitats and specials available within a small area. The Wilge River Valley is accessed along the Zusterstroom road, which descends down into Trichardspoort with its spectacular red cliffs towering above forest-like riverine woodland. This is certainly one of the most scenic drives in the region and offers several species not easily found elsewhere near Gauteng. The kloof has a distinct sub-tropical flavour, which is reinforced by the presence of African Goshawk, Spectacled Weaver and Ashy Flycatcher.

The Vlaklaagte areas comprises a matrix of open grasslands, cultivated fields, copses of alien trees, sizeable wetlands and scenic farm dams, and lies north of Bronkhorstspruit. Low-impact farming activities throughout this picturesque region, together with the relatively large proportion of remaining pristine grassland and wetland habitats, ensure a high diversity of Highveld species. Indeed, the network of public dirt roads throughout this extensive area arguably offers some of the best roadside grassland birding anywhere in Gauteng. Vlaklaagte is a particularly good area for harriers, korhaans, francolins, larks, pipits and cisticolas.

Directions: From the N1-N4 Junction, travel 50 km east towards Bronkhorstspruit and take the R25 offramp. Turn left (north) towards Groblersdal. After 25km turn right towards Zusterstroom (also signposted 'Amanzintaba'). Meet here! (Most of the route is on good gravel roads)

Volgens Birding in Gauteng kronkel hierdie skilderagtige pad deur sommige van die mees diverse voëlhabbitte in die streek, ingeslote die prima Hoëveldse grasveld, slegs 'n hanetree vanaf die indrukwekkende kloof bedek met vogtige woude. Hierdie is een van die minder bekende voëlklykplekke in die streek en is letterlik op die kaart geplaas deur Birding Big Day spanne wat gebruik gemaak het van die voordeel van 'n verskeidenheid van habitatte en spesiale voëls wat binne 'n klein gebied voorkom. Die Wilgeriviervallei word bereik vanaf die Zusterstroom-pad, wat afdaal na Trichardspoort met sy indrukwekkende rooi kranse wat uittoring oor woudagtige rivierbos. Dit is sekerlik een van die mees skilderagtige roetes in die streek en bied verskeie spesies wat nie maklik elders in Gauteng gevind word nie. Die kloof het 'n duidelike subtropiese geur, wat versterk word deur die teenwoordigheid van die Afrikaanse Sperwer, Brilbewer en Blougrysvlieëvanger.

Die Vlaklaagte omgewing bestaan uit 'n matriks van oop grasveld, bewerkte lande, ruigtes van uitheemse bome, groot vleilandte en skilderagtige

plaasdamme, en lê noord van Bronkhorstspruit. Lae impak boerdery aktiwiteite dwarsdeur hierdie aanskoulike streek, tesame met 'n relatief groot gebied van ongerepte grasveld en vleiland habitatte, verseker 'n groot diversiteit van hoëveldspesies. Die netwerk van openbare grondpaaie dwarsdeur die uitgebreide gebied verskaf van die beste grasveld voëlklyk geleenthede vanuit die motor in Gauteng. Vlaklaagte is 'n besondere goeie gebied vir vleivalve, korhane, patrys, lewerikke, koesters en tirkinkies.

Aanwysings: Vanaf die N1-N4 aansluiting, ry 50km oos -> Bronkhorstspruit en neem die R25 afrit. Draai links (noord) -> Groblersdal. Na 25km draai regs -> Zusterstroom (ook aangedui as 'Amanzintaba'). Ontmoet hier! (Grootste deel van die roete is op goeie gruispaaie).

This sanctuary falls within the Blesbokspruit wetland and is a special venue for waterbirds. It regularly produces rarities such as Spotted Crake and Slaty Egret. Other specials include African Crake, African Rail, Great Crested Grebe, Greater Painted Snipe, Red Chested Flufftail and a number of others.

Directions: Take the N1 Rigel off ramp and travel eastwards on the R50 for 64.5km passing Delmas on the way. Turn right on the R42 to Nigel (no route marker). (This turn off is more or less 4km past Delmas.) Go on for 31.8km and turn right at the Marievale sign and travel for another 3.8km to the Picnic Spot. **Meet here!**

Total distance is 100km (1½ hour's drive).

Hierdie reservaat is spesiaal in terme van watervoëldiversiteit en word omring deur die Blesbokspruitvlakte. Ongewone en spesiale voëlspecies word gereeld daar waargeneem en sluit in Gevlekte Riethaan, Rooikeelreier, Afrikaanse Riethaan, Grootriethaan, Kuifkopdobbertjie, Goudsnip, Rooiborsvleikuiken, en vele meer.

Aanwysings: Vanaf die N1 neem die Rigellaan-afrit en ry ooswaarts op die R50 vir 64.5km verby Delmas. Draai regs op die R42 -> Nigel (geen roete-aanduiding). (Hierdie afdraai is ongeveer 4km vanaf Delmas.) Ry reguit aan vir 31.8km en draai regs by die Marievale-bord. Ry vir nog 3.8km

Verlorenkloof Estate near Lydenburg is an exciting birding destination in Mpumalanga. Due to its wonderful array of habitats, birds are both diverse and numerous. To date, 186 species have been recorded on the estate, six of which are endemic to South Africa, while an additional 17 species are endemic to southern Africa. Seven species are listed in the South African Red Data Book – Saddle-billed Stork, Bataleur, Peregrine Falcon, Southern Bald Ibis, Southern Crowned Crane, Blue Crane and Broad-tailed Warbler. The following is a summary of some of the birding highlights at Verlorenkloof Estate: Afro-montane Forest walking through the numerous kloofs, eg. Robin's Kloof and Verlorenkloof. Look out and listen for the following forest species: African Goshawk, Black Cuckoo, Narina Trogan, Olive Woodpecker, Grey Cuckoo-shrike, Orange Ground Thrush, Chorister Robin, Yellow-throated Woodland Warbler, Cape Batis, Blue-mantled Crested Flycatcher and Collared Sunbird. These are all relatively uncommon species, which are more often heard than seen.

After 3km turn LEFT onto the R36 at the "Mashishing (prev Lydenburg R36/N4 Nelspruit via Schoemanskloof)" sign. After 15km, at Bambi, turn LEFT at the "Mashishing (prev Lydenburg R36)" sign (PLEASE NOTE THIS ROAD IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION). After 11km turn LEFT onto a gravel road at the brown "Verlorenkloof" sign, also signposted "Goedehoop". After 2km, turn RIGHT to "Verlorenkloof" (also "Waterval").

NB, GOOGLE MAPS USERS BE AWARE - It tells you to turn left here. Please turn RIGHT and follow OUR last directions below. After 3km, turn LEFT to "Verlorenkloof" (also "Welgedacht"). Continue PAST the dairy for about 3km until you pass the

Staff Residences on your right. Take the following RIGHT and carry on straight till you come to the Lodge in front of you then take the road to the LEFT to Reception

Verlorenkloof Landgoed, naby Lydenburg, Mpumalanga is 'n opwindende voëlklyk-bestemming. Daar is 'n groot verskeidenheid voëlspesies en groot aantal voëls, hoofsaaklik as gevolg van die verskeie habitatte. Die landgoed het al 186 verskillende spesies op die landgoed aangeteken, waarvan 6 Suid-Afrikaanse endemiese spesies is, en 17 endemies is tot Suider Afrika. Die 7 spesies wat in die 'South African Red Data Book' opgeneem is sluit in die – Saalbekooievaar, Berghaan, Swerfvalk, Kalkoenibis, Mahem, Bloukraanvoël en Breeëstersanger. Spesiale voëls wat in die immergroen bergwoude voorkom sluit die volgende in: Afrikaanse Sperwer, Swart Koekoek, Bosloerie, Gryskopspeg, Swartkatakoeroe, Oranjelyster, Lawaaimakerjanfrederik, Geelkeelsanger, Kaapse Bosbontrakkie, Bloukuifvlievanger en Kortbeksuikerbekkie. Hierdie seldsame woudvoëls kom in die woude en klowe (bv. Robin's Kloof en Verlorenkloof) voor en word meer gereeld gehoor as gesien.

Die volgende habitatte kan besigtig word vanaf Verlorenkloof: Immergroen bergwoude, berggrasveld, vleiland en suur graslande.

Bronkhorstspruit dam NR offers a good variety of waterbirds and grassland birds. The reserve encompasses the southern leg of the Bronkhorstspruit dam which includes highveld grassland, seasonal wetlands and agricultural land. The Caspian Tern is most reliable to be seen in winter. Earlier this year the Pink-backed Pelican was also seen here.

Directions: From Pretoria take the N4 east towards Bronkhorstspruit. Take the R25 / Kemptonpark / Delmas offramp and turn right (South). After 3.7 km turn left onto the R42 towards Delmas. The entrance to the reserve is situated on the right, approximately 13.7km further – signposted “Bronkies Angling & Nature Reserve”. Follow this dirt road for 2.8km to the gate.

Bronkhorstspruit dam NR is geleë aan die suidelike been van die dam en dit bestaan uit seisoenale vleiland, hoëveld graslande en landbougrond. 'n Groot verskeidenheid grasveld- en watervoëls is hier te sien. Die Grootsterretjie is redelik algemeen in die wintermaande. Die Kleinpelikaan is ook vroeër vanjaar hier gesien.

Aanwysings: Neem die N4 oos vanaf Pretoria -> Bronkhorstspruit. Neem die R25 / Kemptonpark / Delmas afrit en draai regs (suid). Na 3.7km draai links op die R42 -> Delmas en ry 13.7km. Because of rapidly fluctuating water levels this dam is one of the most exciting birding destinations near Gauteng. The habitat surrounding the dam may change from floodplains to mudflats to dry grasslands within weeks, so the birds are somewhat unpredictable but the birding is always productive. The woodland surrounding the dam ensures a diverse species count. Summer specials can include Slaty Egret, Lesser Spotted Eagle, Osprey, Allen's Gallinule, Lesser Moorhen and Grey Plover, but bird numbers are good throughout the year.

Directions: From the N1 travelling north, take the R513 Sefako Makgatho (Zambezi) offramp. Turn right and proceed for just over 1km to the R573 (Moloto/KwaMhlanya road). Turn left, follow the R573 for 57km, and turn left onto the R568 towards Libangen. After 36km there is a fourway stop, turn left and meet 400m down the road on the left.

As gevolg van die vinnig wisselende watervlakte, is hierdie dam een van die mees opwindende voëlwaarnemingbestemmings naby aan Gauteng. Die habitat rondom die dam kan wissel van vloedvlakte tot modderpoele tot droë grasveld binne weke, so die voëls is ietwat onvoorspelbaar, maar voëlwaarneming is altyd produktief. Die bosveld rondom die dam verseker 'n verskeidenheid van voëlspesies. Besondere somervoëls wat jy daar kan kry is die Rooikeelreier, Gevlekte Arend, Visvalk, Kleinkoningriethaan, Kleinwaterhoender, en Grystrandkiewiet, maar die dam is reg deur die jaar produktief.

Aanwysings: —Vanaf die N1 ry noord en neem die R513 Sefako Makgatho-afrif (Zambezi). Draai regs en ry ongeveer 1 km verder tot by die R573 (Moloto-KwaMhlanga-pad). Bona Thaba is situated 250km from Pretoria, 25km outside of Thabazimbi, and 14km from Marakele National Park, where the Kwaggavlake starts. It consists of an 800ha game farm, 60% mountain and hills with woody kloofs and granite koppie outcrops, rock formations with a cave where bats are found, and 40% plains – a typical Bushveld habitat with sweet and sour grass veld. The farm offers opportunities for hiking and birding on foot. Hiking shoes are essential. The last 11km to the farm is a gravel road (in a relative good condition) but can be driven with a sedan vehicle, up to the lodge where we will be staying. Roads on the farm cannot be driven by sedan vehicle; Pierre has a

Landcruiser and will take the group on two drives at a nominal fee (worth it; been there, got the T-shirt). We will spend one day birding in Marakele National Park (14km from the farm), driving up the Kransberg, looking to find soaring Cape Vultures!

Birding will also be on this beautiful farm with a good selection of bushveld/savanna birds; on a previous occasion an African Scops Owl was seen close by the house. Other specials that could be spotted are: **Gurney's Sugarbird**, Cape Vulture, Little Sparrowhawk, Greater Honeyguide, Southern Pied Babbler, Sentinel Rock-Thrush, Buff-streaked Chat (very confiding), Wailing Cisticola, Grey Tit-Flycatcher, Striped Pipit, Yellow-throated Petronia, Meyer's Parrot to name just a few.

Accommodation: The farm provides accommodation in a converted farm house for **10 adults in 5 comfortable rooms**, each with a bathroom en suite, towels and bedding supplied, air conditioner, two single beds except for room 6 which has a double bed. 

According to *Birding in Gauteng* the legendary Zaagkuildrift Road runs east-west from the town of Pienaar's River to the semi-rural village of Kgomokgomo, tracking the course of the Pienaar's River. In years of good rainfall the river forms a 27km² ephemeral floodplain with birding comparable to the much better known Nyl Floodplain. This combination of rare tropical waterbirds together with excellent mature Acacia woodland arguably offers the richest birding locality in the region, and **certainly one of the best birding spots in southern Africa!** A diverse variety of raptors, cuckoos, bee-eaters, kingfishers, shrikes, warblers and seedeaters are present in the summer months, while (given sufficient rainfall) this is the most reliable site in SA for the rare and elusive River Warbler in late summer. Birding will take place along the road to Kgomokgomo and at Wolfhuiskraal farm where we will have lunch. The entrance fee for day visitors to Wolfhuiskraal is R40 pp.

Directions: From Pretoria head north on the N1 and take the Pienaar's River/Rust de Winter offramp. Turn left at the T-junction and after 700m turn right onto the R101. About 1km further turn left onto a gravel road signposted 'Zaagkuildrift'. **Meet here.**

Lekgalameetse means "Place Of Water", and some important rivers in the province have their source in the beautiful mountains of Lekgalameetse NR. Bordering the Wolkberg Wilderness, this incredibly scenic mountain reserve features crystal clear rivers, countless butterflies, waterfalls and lovely pools. The awesome bird life make it a popular destination for hiking and birding. Part of its appeal is the awesome natural beauty characterised by rolling grassy hills, lush kloofs and indigenous forests. An amazing variety of butterflies can be seen in the forests during late summer. Look out for the elusive Narina Trogon and Samango monkeys clambering in the treetops. Other forest-dwelling birds to spot are the Cape Parrot, Chorister Robin-Chat, Orange Ground-Thrush, Green Twinspot, Black-fronted Bush-Shrike and Barratt's Warbler. In 2009, the following specials were seen; ie Mountain Wagtail, Narina Trogon, Ashy Flycatcher, Olive Bush-Shrike, Collared Sunbird, Scaly-throated Honeyguide,, African Firefinch, African Wood-Owl, Black and Grey Cuckoo-shrike, Yellow-bellied Greenbul, Red-faced Cisticola, Gorgeous Bush-Shrike, White-crested Helmet-Shrike, Striped Pipit, Greater Double-collared Sunbird, Olive Woodpecker, Yellow-streaked Greenbul, Wailing, Lazy and Croaking Cisticolas, Gurney's Sunbird, Blue-mantled Crested Flycatcher, Purple-crested Turaco, Sombre Greenbul, Red-capped Robin-Chat, Bar-throated and Yellow-breasted Apalis, Cape Batis and Chorister Robin-chat.

The Wolkberg is rich in birdlife with 150 bird species to see including the hamerkop, bat hawk, black eagle, lilac-breasted roller, blackcollared and pied barbets, pearlbreasted swallow and crested francolin. Spectacular flaming acacias dot the grassy hills, some covered in thousands of white blossoms or stunning purple-red pods.

There is a nominal entrance fee, payable at the gate. A good, tarred road winds you up through picturesque mountains, up onto the Drakensberg Plateau.

This scenic drive traverses some of the most diverse birding habitats in the region, including prime Highveld grassland, only a stone's throw away from an impressive gorge cloaked with moist woodland. This area is lesser known birding spots in the region and has been quite literally 'put on the map' by Birding Big Day teams taking advantage of the variety of habitats and specials available within a small area. The Wilge River Valley is accessed along the Zusterstroom road, which descends down into Trichardspoort with its spectacular red cliffs towering above forest-like riverine woodland. This is certainly one of the most scenic drives in the region and offers several species not easily found elsewhere near Gauteng. The kloof has a distinct sub-tropical flavour, which is reinforced by the presence of African Goshawk, Spectacled Weaver and Ashy Flycatcher.

Directions: From the N1-N4 junction, travel 50km east towards Bronhorstspruit and take the R25 offramp. Turn left (north) towards Groblersdal. After 25km turn right towards Zusterstroom (also signposted 'Amanzintaba').

Most of the route is on good gravel roads.
